

## 2024 Generation Connect Knowledge Development and Mentoring Programme

17<sup>th</sup> June to 17th November 2024

This knowledge development programme aims to advance learning opportunities for Generation Connect Youth Envoys to empower them become engaged members in their communities, countries and regions of the digital economy, society, and environment as key drivers of the digital world.

The programme will encompass:

- Virtual meetings from both the global and regional teams to foster GCYE community at global and regional levels;
- Virtual interactive sessions aiming to increase knowledge about ITU work and activities to empower educational and social economic empowerment of youth through ICTs. These sessions will focus on BDT's work, particularly on youth-related issues, and provide opportunities for Generation Connect Youth Envoys to interact with experts and professionals in the subject matter;
- Online self-paced trainings on key topics relevant to ITU work on topics of interest for youth educational and socio-economic development, aiming to strengthen GCYE capacity and empower them with the necessary knowledge to be active participants in the digital dialogue and ICT development agenda.

## General Notes on the Programme:

- Most activities will be 1 hour in length.
- Global events will be held either from 12h-13h or 13h-14h CEST to try and accommodate different time zones to the best of our ability.
- We encourage linguistic diversity in our programming. All mandatory online trainings are available in 5 of the UN languages (English, Spanish, French, Russian, and Arabic). At the global level, we will do our best to provide interpretation for our programming, which will be held in English. If interpretation is not possible, we will



provide opportunities for breakout room discussions where youth can engage in discussions in English, Spanish, French, Arabic, and/or Russian. In this case, we may enlist the assistance of GC Alumni who can act as rapporteurs and report back to the larger group to summarize key points discussed in the breakout rooms.
